



# Michigan Mobile Medical Team Relies on Vestige to Protect Clinicians in the Field

## Henry Ford Health Deploys PERSA Panic Button to Keep Lone Workers Safe in Remote, High-Risk Environments

### Overview

Henry Ford Health's Mobile Integrated Health (MIH) team provides critical in-home medical services across Detroit and surrounding counties. To ensure clinician safety during visits—often in challenging neighborhoods—the team turned to Vestige's PERSA safety solution: a discreet, wearable panic button offering real-time alerts and GPS tracking.

### The Challenge

Leonard Adams, head of the MIH team, oversees 13 clinicians dispatched into homes of recently discharged patients. Many of these visits are in areas where safety is uncertain. Despite extensive clinical training, these healthcare workers face risks as lone responders. Leadership recognized the urgent need for a simple, effective solution that could summon immediate help—without escalating already tense situations.

## Solution

Henry Ford Health selected the Vestige PERSA system—a single-button, wearable panic alert device worn on a lanyard. The system activates silently and transmits the user’s GPS location to preset emergency contacts and responders. With customizable escalation protocols and real-time tracking, it offers an unmatched layer of security and peace of mind.

### Why PERSA?

- **Discreet Activation** – Silent alerts don’t escalate already tense situations.
- **GPS Location Sharing** – Tracks and shares user location instantly for rapid response.
- **Custom Notifications** – Configurable to fit unique team protocols and alerting hierarchies.

The solution is now a required part of every MIH clinician’s gear, tested regularly and supported by internal escalation plans.
